

First day (signposted in red) – SS 2 – 5 Crastazza

First driver: 10h50 – 15h45

Km: 33,96

Road closing time: from 7h50 to 19h15 on 16th May

Zone C at 2,80 km and at 27,34 km from the start

Access road:

1. From Olbia follow the signs road to Nuoro and go on to the State Road SS 131dcn, which is a four-lane State Road,
2. after 14 km, at level with the 131th km, take the exit to Padru,
3. go along for about 10 km and having reached Padru go on the left to Buddusò,
4. after about 17 km, at the crossroads to Budoni-Alà dei Sardi, go on to Alà dei Sardi,
5. after 3 km, at the crossroads to Monti-Alà dei Sardi, turn left on to the State Road SS389 direction Alà dei Sardi,
6. pass through Alà dei Sardi and go on to Buddusò,
7. At the entrance to Buddusò, leave the junction to Pattada to the right and pass through the village following the signs road to Bitti,
8. having left the village, turn left on to the State Road SS 389 direction Bitti,
9. after about 4 km, turn left, at level with the Nuraghe Loelle. When you reach the gravel road, having left the Nuraghe on left, go on to the wide gravel road on right, in the opposite way used by the Special Stage SS7-10 Punta Pianedda the next day,
10. continue on this way following with attention the road signs staged by the organization for about the full 10 km.

Notes:

In the final part the access road is characterized by strong/important/big slopes and by stretches with narrow carriageways. For this reason it's forbidden the entrance to bulky or weak vehicles, in particular to campers or caravans. Having reached the lake, you must park along the gravel road on the left. You have to come back to the lake and go on foot along the gravel straight road.

After 500 m on foot, you will reach the Special Stage at level with a bend to left inside the forest.

Going in the opposite way of the SS along a straight stretch of 300 m, you will reach a bend on right, which the racing cars drive on to go inside the forest.

Going on to the left for 240 m, in the opposite way of the SS, you will reach the famous hump, which characterized this Stage. This hump is very spectacular: it's faced up with high speed because before it there is a straight stretch of more than 150m and a wide bend to the left.

If you go to the right for 140 m, you will reach the part of the Zone C, a very narrow hair pin bend from a light slope to another one more marked.

Wide Public zone with many space for the spectators and excellent visibility everywhere.

Note!

Most of the gravel access road you go along, after having left the State Road S 389, will be the course of the race of the Special Stage SS7-10 Punta Pianedda of next day.

We suggest that you do not stay overnight nearby this State Road because you risk to being locked in this area.

In any case you do not leave your vehicles unattended nearby the course because you could cause the cancellation of the race.

Zone D at 6,13 km and at 24,76 km from the start

Access road:

1. From Olbia follow the signs road to Nuoro and go on to the State Road SS 131dcn, which is a four-lane State Road,
2. after 14 km, at level with the 131th km, take the exit to Padru,
3. go along for about 10 km and having reached Padru go on the left to Buddusò,
4. after about 17 km, at the crossroads to Budoni-Alà dei Sardi, go on to Alà dei Sardi,
5. after 3 km, at the crossroads to Monti-Alà dei Sardi, turn left on to the State Road SS389 direction Alà dei Sardi,
6. pass through Alà dei Sardi and go on to Buddusò,
7. At the entrance to Buddusò, leave the junction to Pattada to the right and pass through the village following the signs road to Bitti,
8. having left the village, turn left on to the State Road SS 389 direction Bitti,

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9. after about 4 km, turn left, at level with the Nuraghe Loelle. When you reach the gravel road, having left the Nuraghe on left, go on to the wide gravel road on right, in the opposite way used by the Special Stage SS7-10 Punta Pianedda the next day,
10. Continue on the this way following with attention the signs road staged by the organization for the full 7,4 km.

Notes:

Excellent access road to a wide Public Zone with spacious parking opportunities and wide visibility everywhere. Wide hair pin bend to the left followed by a long straight stretch of more then 300 m, lightly curvilinear and with a large carriageway. At the end there is a narrow bend to the right, which goes on to a narrower road. If you go for about 500 m inside the forest in the opposite way of the Stage, you will reach a part with many interesting passages and many humps. Going along the abovementioned straight stretch and go on foot for 1 hundred m, you reach the second part of the Zone C, where there is an interesting and long shaped bend which crosses a gate and a bridge.

Note!

Most of the gravel access road you go along, after having left the State Road S 389, will be the course of the race of the Special Stage SS7-10 Punta Pianedda of next day. We suggest that you do not stay overnight nearby this State Road because you risk to being locked in this area. In any case you do not leave your vehicles unattended nearby the course because you could cause the cancellation of the race.

Zone E at 9,58 km from the start

Access road:

1. From Olbia follow the signs road to Nuoro and go on to the State Road SS 131dcn, which is a four-lane State Road,
2. after 14 km, at level with the 131th km, take the exit to Padru,
3. go along for about 10 km and having reached Padru go on the left to Buddusò,
4. after about 17 km, at the crossroads to Budoni-Alà dei Sardi, go on to Alà dei Sardi,
5. after 3 km, at the crossroads to Monti-Alà dei Sardi, turn left on to the State Road SS389 direction Alà dei Sardi,
6. pass through Alà dei Sardi and go on to Buddusò,
7. At the entrance to Buddusò, leave the junction to Pattada to the right and pass through the village following the signs road to Bitti,
8. having left the village, turn left on to the State Road SS 389 direction Bitti,
9. after about 11 km turn to the left on to the Provincial road SP 50 direction Mamone,
10. after about 8,5 km you will find on the right the junction to Bitti and on the left the entrance of the State Forestry "FD Castrazza". Here will start the special Stage.

Notes:

Excellent access road because of it's a wide and well asphalted Provincial Road with many parking facilities along it, particularly in the wide straight stretch of about 500 m between the entrance of "FD Castrazza" and Mamone. Excellent visibility of a short straight stretch with a light slope and with a medium carriageway. There is a narrow hair pin bend, which ends, grazing the asphalt of the Provincial Road SP 50. Walking along the Stage for 1,6 km, you will reach a very wide hair pin bend in light slope. There is a big natural amphitheatre, which can hold spectators. From here you can watch about 300 m of the Special Stage, that is the passage on the hair pin bend.
