

Second day (signposted in blue) – SS 8 – 11 Monte Lerno

First driver: 10h31 – 15h48

Km: 29,31

Road closing time: from 07h31 to 20h30 on 17th May

Zone M at 14,01 from the start

Access road:

1. From Olbia follow the signs road to Nuoro and go on to the State Road SS 131dcn, which is a four-lanen State Road,
2. after 14 km, at level with the 131th km, take the exit to Padru,
3. go along for about 10 km and having reached Padru go on the left to Buddusò,
4. after about 17 km, at the crossroads to Budoni-Alà dei Sardi, go on to Alà dei Sardi,
5. after 3 km, at the crossroads to Monti-Alà dei Sardi, turn left on to the State Road SS389 direction Alà dei Sardi,
6. pass through Alà dei Sardi and go on to Buddusò,
7. at the entrance of Buddusò, turn right to Pattada on to the State Road SS 389 and pass through the village following this road,
8. at level with the 2th km of the State Road SS389 d.A., turn right on to an asphalted road, which will become narrower and gravel after a few kms,
9. continue along this road, which goes on an hill for about 3,8 km, ignoring the several crossroads you will find before. Follow with attention the special signs roads staged by the organization.

Notes:

Good access road and good parking opportunities.

Excellent visibility of 500m of Special Stage, characterized by a straight stretch with some easy, wide and fast bends and by wide hair pin bend to the right, which goes on to a light sloping stretch.

Very safety and spacious Public Zone.

Zone N at 16,08 km from the start

Access road:

1. from Olbia follow the signs road to Nuoro and go on to the State Road SS 131dcn, which is a four-lane State Road,
2. after 14 km, at level with the 131th km, take the exit to Padru,
3. go along for about 10 km and having reached Padru go on the left to Buddusò
4. after about 17 km, at the crossroads to Budoni-Alà dei Sardi, go on to Alà dei Sardi
5. after 3 km, at the crossroads to Monti-Alà dei Sardi, turn left on to the State Road SS389 direction Alà dei Sardi,
6. pass through Alà dei Sardi and go on to Buddusò,
7. at the entrance of Buddusò, turn right to Pattada on to the State Road SS 389 and pass through the village following this road,
8. at level with the 2th km of the State Road SS389, turn right on to an asphalted road, which will become narrower and gravel after a few kms,
9. continue along this road, which goes on an hill for about 3,5 km. When you reach the top of the slope, in the Nodu Balestreris's area, turn to the right ignoring the several crossroads you will find before.
10. Follow with attention the special signs roads staged by the organization.

Notes:

Quite narrow access road. For this reason you must drive slowly and with attention.

Spacious parking area at the finish on to a wide upland/plateau.

Just in front of the parking area, there is a wide and speedy bend. You can watch it in safety from close up, thanks to a natural stand, which is inside the bend.

Going in the opposite of the Special Stage for 200 m, you can go from the parking area to some very visible wide bends, which are in light slope.

Another way to enjoy the SS is going for 250 m in the same way of the Stage. You can reach a well visible, wide and fast shaped bend.

Note!

After the junction, which is at about 3,5 from the State Road SS389, mentioned above in the point n°9 of the access road description, you reach a protected area, where the camping is strictly prohibited.

For this reason turning to left, at the level with the junction, there is a height limiter to prevent the entrance to vehicles, which are more than 2m high, like campers or caravans.

Zone O at 18,87 and 25,21 km from the start

Access road:

1. from Olbia follow the signs road to Nuoro and go on to the State Road SS 131dcn, which is a four-lane State Road,
2. after 14 km, at level with the 131th km, take the exit to Padru,
3. go along for about 10 km and having reached Padru go on the left to Buddusò
4. after about 17 km, at the crossroads to Budoni-Alà dei Sardi, go on to Alà dei Sardi,
5. after 3 km, at the crossroads to Monti-Alà dei Sardi, turn left on to the State Road SS389 direction Alà dei Sardi,
6. pass through Alà dei Sardi and go on to Buddusò
7. at the entrance of Buddusò, turn right to Pattada on to the State Road SS 389 and pass through the village following this road,
8. at level with the 2th km of the State Road SS389 d.A., turn right along an asphalted road, which will become narrower and gravel after a few kms,
9. continue along this road, which goes on an hill for about 3,5 km. When you reach the top of the slope, in the Nodu Balestreris's area, turn to the right ignoring the several crossroads you will find before.
10. continue along this road, which goes on the hill for about 3,5 km. Having reached/when you reach the top of the slope, in the Nodu Balestreris's area, turn right ignoring the several crossroads you will find before.
11. Follow with attention the special signs roads staged by the organization.

Notes:

The final part of the access road is very narrow and steep. For this reason you must avoid parking along this access road.

A few parking opportunities at the finish and along the lake.

We suggest to go on foot along the 500m of the final part, which is after the junction to the road, which leads the Media to the Public Zone P.

Wide T crossroads nearby the Sa Jone Lake. Before there is a long straight stretch next to the lake with some wide fast bends and after there is a hair pin bend to the left, which goes to a straight stretch of about 100 m. This road ends with a wide and fast bend to the right. Good visibility of this bend.

Going on foot to the crossroads and turning right, in the opposite way of the turning of the cars, after about 200 m, you will reach another wide crossroads, like the first one, which goes to an interesting light slope of about 600m. At the end of this slope, there is a wide and very fast hair pin bend from which you can have a wide visibility.

Note!

After the junction, which is at about 3,5 from the State Road SS389, mentioned above in the point n°9 of the access road description, you reach a protected area, where the camping is strictly prohibited.

For this reason turning to left, at the level with the junction, there is a height limiter for/to preventing the entrance to vehicles, which are more than 2m high, like campers or caravans.

Zone P at 21,17 km from the start

Access road:

1. from Olbia follow the signs road to Nuoro and go on to the State Road SS 131dcn, which is a four-lane State Road,
2. after 14 km, at level with the 131th km, take the exit to Padru
3. go along for about 10 km and having reached Padru go on the left to Buddusò
4. after about 17 km, at the crossroads to Budoni-Alà dei Sardi, go on to Alà dei Sardi,
5. after 3 km, at the crossroads to Monti-Alà dei Sardi, turn left on to the State Road SS389 direction Alà dei Sardi,
6. pass through Alà dei Sardi and go on to Buddusò
7. at the entrance of Buddusò, turn right to Pattada on to the State Road SS 389 and pass through the village following this road,
8. After 5 km from the exit of the village, turn right direction Nuraghe Lerno, along a road, which is asphalted at the beginning. Follow with attention the vertical signs road staged by the organization.

Notes:

Access road characterized by the last 3 kms, which are first with gravel roadbed then with asphalted one. The carriage way is very narrow and is very sloping. For this reason it's forbidden the entrance to particular bulky or weak vehicles, like campers or caravans.

Safe parking opportunity only in the clearings near the stretch close to the Special Stage.

The spectators, which will park along the final part of the access road, must pay attention not to hinder the others ones, which are coming or leaving.

The access road goes to a wide hair pin bend on the right and to a fast stretch of about 300 m, which ends with the famous "Mickey's jump". This hump makes the cars to jump up.

Wide visibility thanks to wonderful natural amphitheatre. The organization recommend to take place in the foreseen areas beyond the dry-stone wall, which limits in a natural way the dangerous area.

Note!

Don't try to reach the start of the Special stage, because of the scarce wideness of the interested road, it will be reserved to the only transit of the racing cars and closed to the traffic from 07h01 to 20h00.

Along this road you must avoid parking vehicles, which could hinder the regular transit of the cars, because of you could cause the cancellation of the Special Stage.



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
