
2011 FIA WRC SPORTING REGULATIONS / Article 61.6 - Tyre supply / Non-priority drivers

When driven by non-priority drivers, all 2WD cars, Gp. R4 and Gp. N 2-litre turbocharged cars may use free tyres. Such tyres must be in conformity with Appendix J and Appendix V of these regulations.

APPLICABLE TO WRC ACADEMY CREWS ONLY

- 1) **SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS / Article 8.4 - Fuel and fuel distribution for WRC Academy drivers** (new)
WRC Academy driver must use commercially available pump fuel 95 octane only, dispensed from pumps at filling stations along the route which are marked in the Road-book.
- 2) **SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS / Article 11.9 - Components sealing for WRC Academy drivers** (new)
For each car of the WRC Academy drivers a transmission (one mounted and one spare) will be sealed at scrutineering. The spare transmission may be marked at pre-rally scrutineering or during the event.
- 3) **SPEC-SHEET** (new)
WRC Academy driver's cars must be conform to the "Specification Sheet" (Spec-Sheet) provided during scrutineering.
